


Check Your Case Status With USCIS

What is the Case Status Tool?

- The tool is available online at: <https://egov.uscis.gov/casestatus/landing.do>
- Those with pending immigration applications or petitions (such as an asylum application or Employment Authorization Document application) with USCIS may track the status of their application(s) by using the tool.
- If you filed your application or petition online through your myUSCIS online account, you may choose to receive automatic alerts via email and/or text message when there is an update instead of using the case status tool.

How to Use the Case Status Tool

- All you need is the Receipt Number of your application or petition to check your case status.
 - The Receipt Number has three letters and 10 numbers.
 - You can find the Receipt Number on the Receipt Notice you (or your attorney or representative) should have received shortly after submitting the application or petition.
- Enter the Receipt Number in the Case Status Tool.
- Then, click "Check Status".
- It will direct you to another page with information about the status of your application or petition.


